The **Let's Inspire Bihar (LIB)** movement, which has steadily emerged as one of India's most expansive citizen-led development initiatives, is set to organise the **Bihar Development Summit 2026 at T-Hub, Hyderabad on 18 January 2026**, following the resounding success of its recently concluded **Bihar @ 2047 Vision Conclave (Season 3) in Bengaluru**.

Founded on **22 March 2021** by senior IPS officer **Mr. Vikas Vaibhav (2003 batch), Inspector General, Government of Bihar**, Let's Inspire Bihar envisions the creation of a developed Bihar within a developed India by 2047. At the heart of the movement lies a simple yet powerful resolve — that no citizen should be compelled to leave Bihar for education, employment, or healthcare. Rooted in the principles of education, egalitarianism, and entrepreneurship, the campaign consciously transcends divisions of caste, religion, gender, and ideology, and draws inspiration from Bihar's rich civilisational, intellectual, and entrepreneurial legacy.

Over the last few years, Let's Inspire Bihar has evolved from a regional initiative into a national movement, connecting more than 3,00,000 determined individuals across India and abroad, including over 20,000 entrepreneurs and senior corporate professionals. Through its chapters operating in multiple states and countries, the campaign has been mobilising intellectual capital, professional

expertise, and entrepreneurial energy towards building a sustainable development ecosystem for Bihar.

This expanding national footprint was clearly visible at the Bihar @ 2047 Vision Conclave (Season 3) held recently in Bengaluru, which marked a historic milestone for the movement. The conclave witnessed the participation of over 1,200 delegates, including nearly 900 entrepreneurs, industry leaders, IT professionals, start-up founders, academicians, and thought leaders from across India and several international locations. The event provided a robust platform for dialogue on Bihar's development roadmap and further refined the Bihar @ 2047 Vision Document, which outlines long-term strategies for inclusive growth, entrepreneurship-led employment, and institutional strengthening.

Encouraged by the overwhelming response in Bengaluru, Let's Inspire Bihar is now bringing this national dialogue to Hyderabad, one of India's foremost innovation and start-up hubs. The Bihar Development Summit 2026 at T-Hub is envisioned as a high-impact platform to connect entrepreneurs, investors, start-up founders, professionals, and academicians from South India and beyond with emerging opportunities in Bihar. The summit aims to foster cross-regional collaboration and position Bihar as a promising destination for investment, innovation, and enterprise creation.

The Hyderabad program will be graced by eminent public representatives, educationists, eminent scholars, and social leaders, including Shri Etala Rajender, (Hon'ble MP, Malkajgiri & Ex-Minister, Government of Telangana), Shri Vikas Vaibhav, a Senior IPS officer from Bihar Cadre, Shri Mithilesh Tiwari (Hon'ble MLA), Shri Rajeev Ranjan Singh (Hon'ble MLA), Shri Ratnesh Kumar Kushwaha (Hon'ble MLA), Maulana Kalbe Rushaid Rizvi; an eminent religious scholar, Shri Shamael Ahmed (National President, Private Schools Association), Shri Akhilesh Singh (Divine Public School), and Shri Sonu Sharma (BJP Leader),

among others. Their presence reflects the inclusive and plural character of the movement and its ability to bring together diverse voices on a common developmental platform.

Speaking about the Hyderabad summit, the Let's Inspire Bihar leadership emphasised that entrepreneurship-driven development is central to curbing migration and ensuring dignified livelihoods within Bihar. The summit will focus on building practical linkages between policy intent, investment interest, and grassroots aspirations, especially in the areas of start-ups, MSMEs, skill development, and innovation-led growth.

Following the Hyderabad summit, the movement will organise the Bihar Development Summit 2026 at Talkatora Stadium, New Delhi on 22 February 2026, which is expected to serve as a major national congregation consolidating intellectual discourse, citizen participation, and institutional engagement around Bihar's long-term development vision.

With successful programs in Bengaluru, the upcoming summit in Hyderabad, and the forthcoming Delhi event, Let's Inspire Bihar continues to demonstrate that India's journey towards Viksit Bharat @ 2047 is inseparable from Bihar's transformation. The campaign has reiterated its appeal to entrepreneurs, professionals, students, academicians, and socially conscious citizens across the country to actively participate in this collective nation-building effort.
